# KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION SEPTEMBER 2021

In order for us to better prepare for the 2021-2022 school year <u>parents are requested to register their children for Kindergarten</u> by coming to the appropriate school office from January 22 to January 29, 2021, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

<u>Please enrol in the school within whose catchment area your residence is located</u>. If you wish to attend a different school, your request will then be considered. Requests are considered on a priority basis. Please see "Attending the School of Your Choice" below for more information. An exception we make is that parents who have older children currently at the K-3 level may enrol their beginning Kindergarten child at the same school. We attempt to keep families together when possible.

Children born in 2016 or earlier are eligible to enrol. We are asking all parents who are not enrolling their Kindergarten age children in a school program to let us know. Catchment Middle years (Grades 5 to 8) students attend École Morden Middle School. **English Kindergarten Program** 10 The English Kindergarten program is arranged in half-day, every day classes at both Minnewasta School and Maple Leaf Elementary School in both the morning and afternoon. **French Immersion Program** Early years (K to 4) French Immersion Program (FI) is offered at Maple Leaf School.
