DESCRIPTION

The Western School Division is looking for a dedicated and enthusiastic educator to join our team in the role of **French Language Support Teacher**. This role is vital to supporting and enhancing the Division's French language programming, which includes both French Immersion and French within the English Program.

The French Language Support Teacher will play a key role in supporting the development and delivery of French language instruction within both the English Program and the French Immersion program across the division. This role includes supporting schools in fostering cultural development, supporting grant applications and reporting, networking with French consultants, teachers, and Elders, and sourcing relevant materials which will enhance French language programs and initiatives. The successful candidate will be able to write and accurately report on grants and grant objectives. Experience with data collecting for reporting purposes would be an asset.

The French Language Support Teacher will also assist the Division's Senior Administration in supporting the growth and success of both French Immersion and French language offerings in the English Program.

This position reports to the Assistant Superintendent.

The successful candidate has knowledge about French Immersion teaching methodology and philosophy, has experience teaching within the grade K to 12 system. The incumbent will be capable of organizing and/or leading Professional Development for the Early Start French and French Communication and Culture teacher groups.

The candidate must be a qualified teacher possessing a valid Manitoba teaching certificate or the ability to obtain such. They must demonstrate a child-centred approach, excellent interpersonal skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills, flexibility, and ability to handle change, including the capabilities to step up into home class teacher as required. They must be willing and able to work as part of a team, yet function independently when required. The ability to speak, write, and teach fluently in both the French and English languages is a requirement.

A condition of employment with the Western School Division is a satisfactory Criminal Record Check, Vulnerable Sector Search, Child Abuse Registry Check, and an agreement by the applicant to disclose criminal record and/or Abuse Registry record information to the Division. The successful candidate will be responsible for any service charges incurred. Persons must present this information prior to their first day of work.
