KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION SEPTEMBER 2020

In order for us to better prepare for the 2020-2021 school year <u>parents are requested to register their children for Kindergarten</u> by coming to the appropriate school office from January 24 to January 31, 2020, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

<u>Please enrol in the school within whose catchment area your residence is located</u>. If you wish to attend a different school, your request will then be considered. Requests are considered on a priority basis. Please see "Attending the School of Your Choice" below for more information. An exception we make is that parents who have older children currently at the K-3 level may enrol their beginning Kindergarten child at the same school. We attempt to keep families together when possible.

Children born in 2015 or earlier are eligible to enrol. We are asking all parents who are not enrolling their Kindergarten age children in a school program to let us know. We need to be aware of possible future enrollments.

Open House

Western School Division will be holding a Kindergarten Parent Information Session on January 23, 2020 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Maple Leaf Elementary School.

We look forward to seeing all the new Kindergarten parents on this evening.

Elementary School Organization

Maple Leaf Elementary School and Minnewasta School are for early years (Kindergarten to Grade 4) students.
Middle years (Grades 5 to 8) students attend École Morden Middle School.

English Kindergarten Program

The English Kindergarten program is arranged in half-day, every day classes at both **Minnewasta School** and **Maple Leaf Elementary School** in both the morning and afternoon.

French Immersion Program

Early years (K to 4) French Immersion Program (FI) is offered at Maple Leaf School. This program begins in Kindergarten. Kindergarten is arranged in half-day, every day classes. More information is available at both early years schools. Grades 5 to 8 FI students attend École Morden Middle School.

Attending the School of Your Choice

Provincial legislation permits parents to choose which school to send their child to, including schools outside of their home division. However, schools must accept students on a priority basis.

- First, students within that school's catchment area as designated by the Division.
- Second, students residing in the School Division.
- Last, students from outside the Division.

Space, program availability, and the general well-being of other students will be considered in making the final decision about school of choice applications.

Catchment areas are designated as follows:

Minnewasta School – 1 Academy Drive, Morden

- Area south of North Railway and area west of Mountain St.
- All rural students.

Maple Leaf Elementary School – 225-12th Street, Morden

- Area north of South Railway St. and east of Mountain St.
- All early years (K-4) FI students
