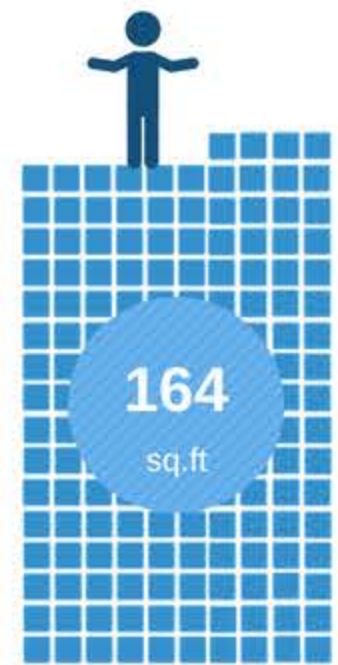
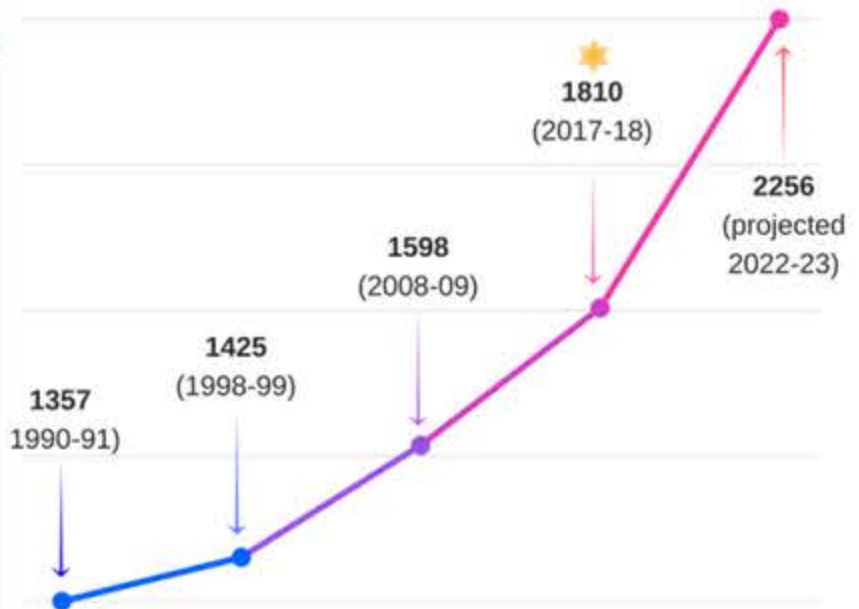


FACTS ABOUT SPACE

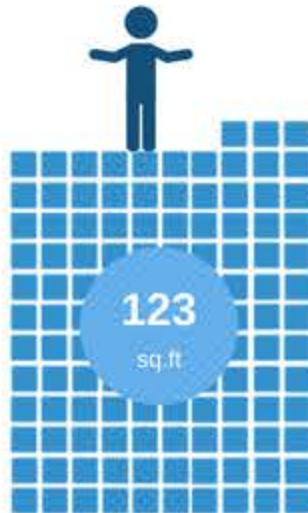
AT WESTERN SCHOOL DIVISION
