

EAL Remote Learning Activities

Week of May 11-15

Below you will find some **optional** activities for your child to do. These activities are meant to be done in English as much as possible. Activities posted will focus on speaking, listening, reading, and writing in English. These are not assigned grades, they are offered to encourage English communication during this time away from the school.

1. Do the Out My Window writing activity for Mrs. Keith. Share it with me first so we can work on adding lots of detail to your sentences. If you're not sure what this activity is, email me and I'll explain it to you.
2. Go for a listening walk. Walk or sit outside and take a few minutes to pay attention to everything you hear. Find a paper and draw a picture showing what you heard. If you're able, write a few words or sentences to explain your drawing. Use as much description as you can so I can read it and feel like I was there, hearing the same things.
3. Pretend you are a server at your own restaurant. Before lunch or supertime, take everyone's orders (writing them down on a pad of paper). Then help prepare the food and serve it to your guests. Try using the same language you hear when you go out to eat ("may I take your order?", "Our specials today are ____").
