

EAL Remote Learning Activities

Week of April 20-24

Below you will find some **optional** activities for your child to do. These activities are meant to be done in English as much as possible. Activities posted will focus on speaking, listening, reading, and writing in English. These are not assigned grades, they are offered to encourage English communication during this time away from the school.

1. Sign in to your Sora or Overdrive accounts (each student has a designated log-in and password—ask your homeroom teacher for this information if you’ve misplaced it) and listen to read alouds. As you listen, follow along with the text. Afterwards, talk to a family member about the book. What did you like and why? What did you dislike and why? Do you have any questions after reading? Did you learn anything new?
2. Make a memory game to play at home. Make a set of cards (there must be 2 of each card) with any of the following vocabulary—school items, things in our community, community helpers, shapes, alphabet, numbers, words you know, clothing, words about seasons, food, or anything else you’d like to practice. Take turns flipping over 2 cards and trying to find a match. You could also write 1 word in English and 1 in your first language to practice both at the same time!
3. Start a video journal. Record yourself talking and email it to me. I’ll tape a response and send it back!
