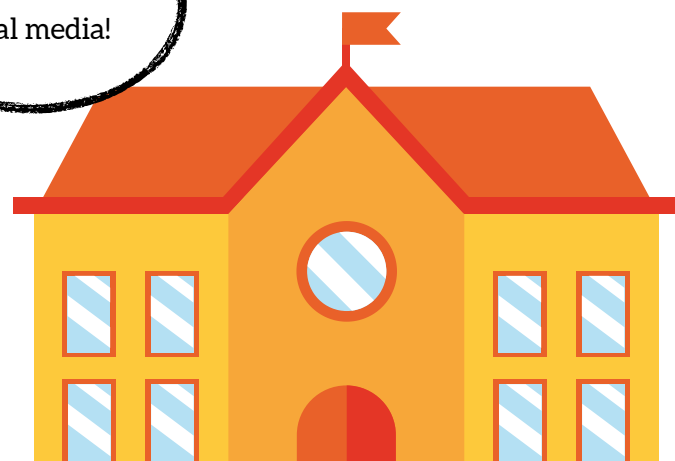

"FILL THE CART"

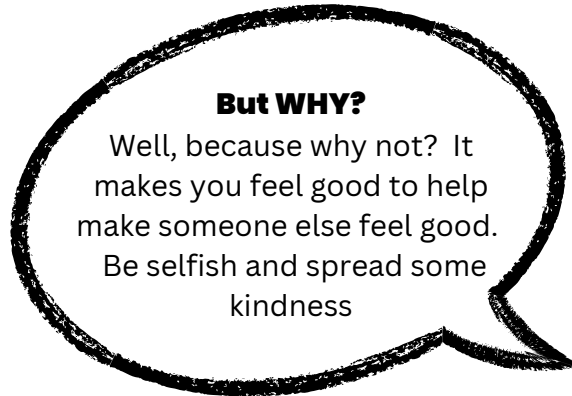


What is **THE CART**?
